


Welcome to Breece Cloud. This is a Userguide about using your new Breece Cloud ESL system.


To Use the system you must open a Browser:

The Dashboard gives an overview of the installation and the System Operation. The Dashboard contains of 4 columns: **Displays – Data – Equipment – Installation(s)**




Green is good

Dashboard - Displays:




Under Displays at the Dashboard, it is possible to se the amount of displays in use and ready to use and a total number of displays on the installation.

Under Operation Status there are Warnings and Errors from the displays.

Succeded are green





Communicators:








Display Administration:




At the buttom of the display administration page it is possible to make a display batch. Push **DisplayBatch** to add, Delete, Force Update or ping either one or several displays. A text file with the display seriel numbers can also be uploaded in case of many displays.



It is also possible til enter or scan display seriel number in to the great grey area and use til Add, Delete, Force update og ping buttoms.

Add Display:

Uset his buttom to add a single display by its serieal number. Remember to place til display under the Master Communicator to add display(s) to b econfigured to the system.





New assignment:

Here it is possible to asign a single display to a product at the time. First scan or enter the display seriel number and next scan or enter the product EAN number.




Export Filtered List:

Choose the displays to export. Press the buttom and the chosen displays will be exportet to a file in Excel.Her vælges de displays.




Product administration:

Search and find given products among the products imported.





By pressing the Product History buttom the history for the product import is shown. If there is an failed or partial failed import, it is possible to right clickat the one and get import detail, to find the errors in the import.



The Export Filtered List buttom is used to download a list of products.

Product audits shows what product numbers are updated and also the variables in the update.







Jobs:

The job button shows the job page. The page can be set to auto update every 15 or 25 seconds.

The page is devided in to 2 parts, The Job status and the job type.



StatusDetails shows what happens to each single display.

Clear Waiting Jobs clears the jobs.
